Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishers,
Yachtsmen and Seafarers

Corrib Gas Pipelines Inspection and Nearshore Survey, Co. Mayo

1. Notice of Activity

The Department of Transport has been advised by Vermilion Exploration & Production Ireland Limited of a campaign of inspection of the Corrib near shore pipeline and umbilical off Co. Mayo. Weather permitting, the works are due to commence on the **18 May 2026** and will last for approximately 10 days. All work dates are subject to weather and operational constraints.

2. Location of Activity

Visual and acoustic surveys will be conducted by means of vessel mounted sensors, cameras, ROV and towed Side Scan Sonar.

The nearshore pipeline and umbilical sections will be inspected from the nearest point accessible inshore at high tide, progressing to offshore, until a suitable overlap with the offshore inspection is achieved.

3. Details of Survey Vessels

The vessel "**Bella C**" (call sign: **EI3325**) will undertake the near shore survey scope while the vessels "**Macbel**" (call sign: **EIHL5**) and the "**Blue Eagle**" (call sign: **EI6808**) will both provide safety and welfare support to "**Bella C**". The vessels will be listening on VHF CH 16 throughout the project.

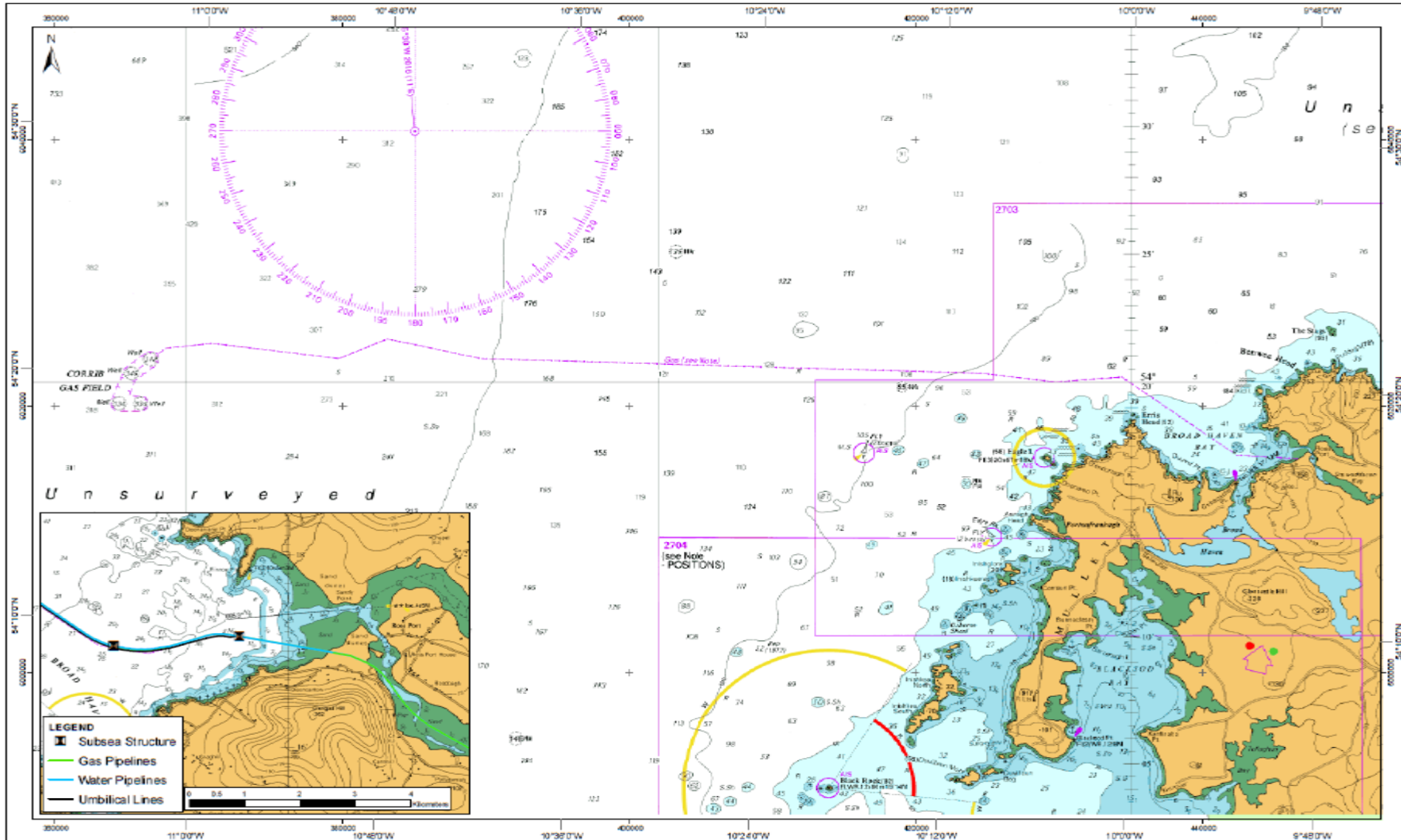
