



## Marine Notice No. 50 of 2023

*Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishers,  
Yachtsmen and Seafarers*

### Codling Wind Park – Geophysical Survey

#### 1. Notice of Activity

The Department of Transport has been advised by Codling Wind Park Ltd that a geophysical survey will be conducted in the shallow sub tidal area of South Dublin Bay and also around the Pigeon Park area in the River Liffey channel. The project works will commence on or around **14 August 2023** and will continue through to early **September 2023**, subject to weather and operational constraints

#### 2. Location of Operations

The geophysical survey will take place at two different locations as set out in the tables below.

- Shallow Subtidal Area in South Dublin Bay;

### 3. Details of Survey Vessels

The survey operations will be conducted by the **AMS Panther** (call sign **2EHC2**).

The **AMS Panther** will be conducting geophysical surveys for several days which may extend in the event of poor weather conditions. Throughout survey operations, the vessel will be displaying the appropriate lights and shapes as required under the COLREGS Rule 27(b). The vessel will be towing survey equipment and will be restricted in its ability to manoeuvre during survey operations. Vessels within the vicinity are therefore requested to leave a wide berth.

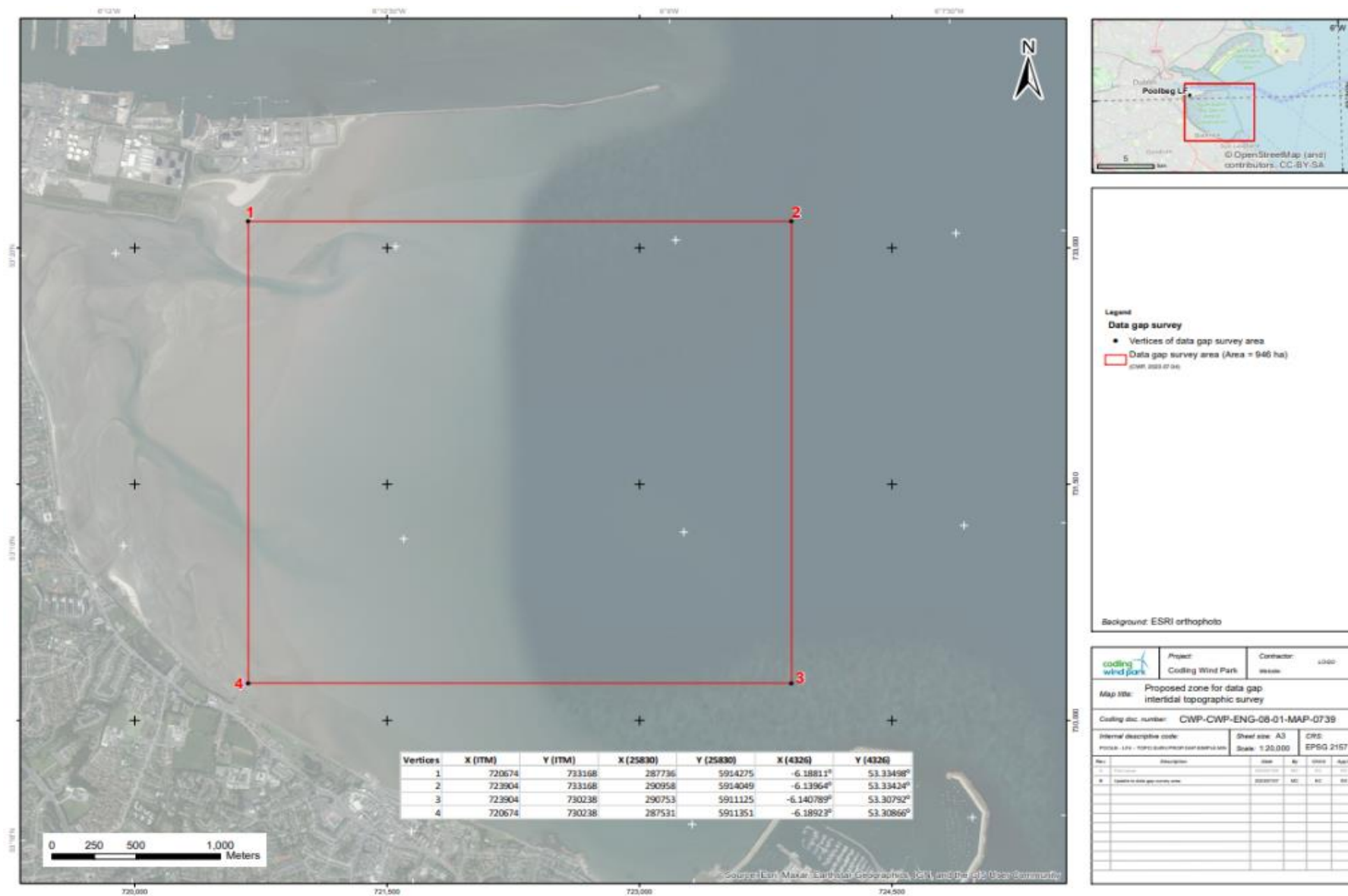
