



## Marine Notice No. 65 of 2025

Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishers,  
Yachtsmen and Seafarers

### Shannon Estuary Deployment of Acoustic Doppler Current Profilers

#### 1. Notice of Activity

The Department of Transport has been notified by Gas Networks Ireland that Green Rebel Ltd will deploy 3 Acoustic Doppler Current Profilers (ADCPs) at various nearshore locations within the Shannon Estuary. Identical seabed frames with an anti-trawl configuration will be deployed at each of the 3 locations as shown in the Appendix to this Marine Notice. The deployment took place on **26 November 2025**, subject to weather and operational constraints, and the ADCPs will remain in place for up to four months. A mid-campaign service visit will take place after approximately **6 weeks** in which the 3 seabed frames will be recovered, the measurement data downloaded and then redeployed.

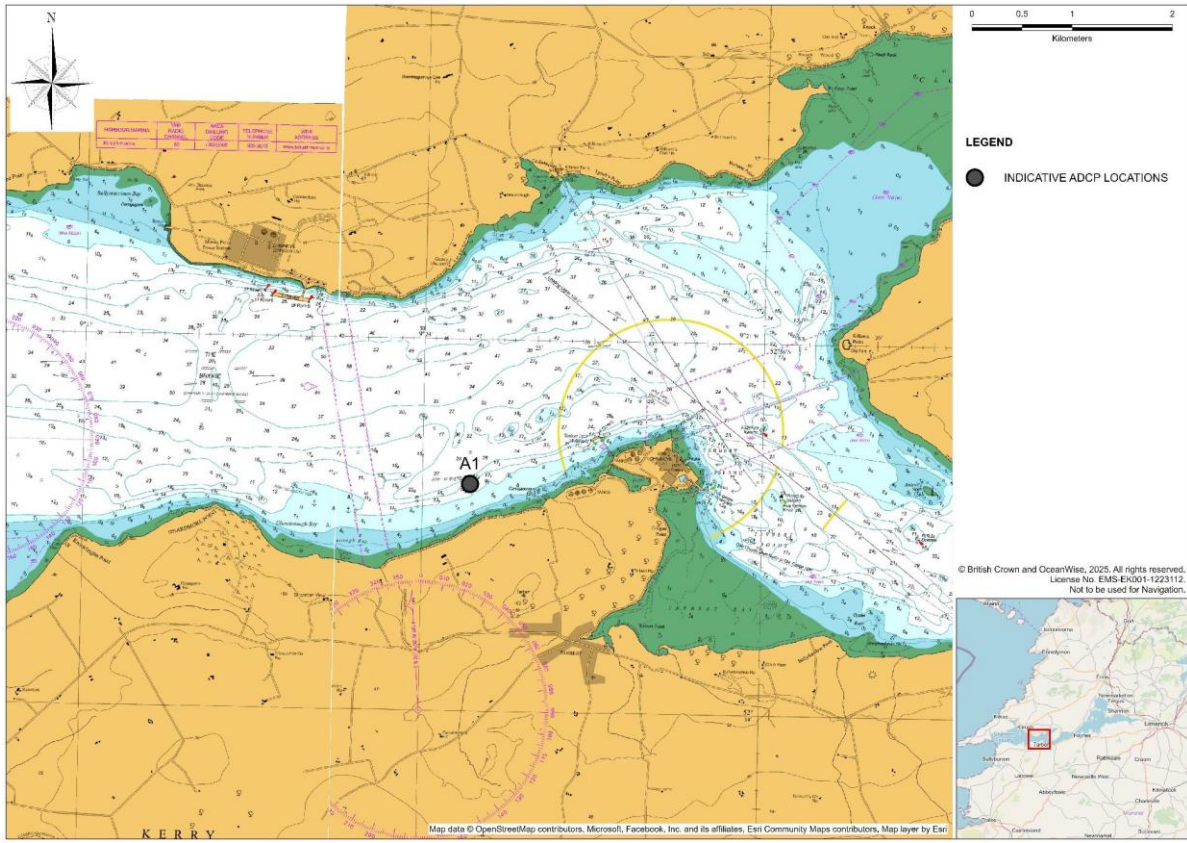
