Greenlink Interconnector Cable Route Inspection Irish Sea

1. Notice of Activity

The Department of Transport has been informed that a geophysical survey of the Greenlink Interconnector will be undertaken in the Irish Sea. This will be conducted by an environmental video survey using a drop-down camera along perpendicular transects at 12 stations, with three transects at each station. The inspection will be conducted from **21 May to 10 June 2026**, subject to weather and operational constraints

2. Location of Activity

The Greenlink Interconnector runs between Ireland and Wales through the Irish Sea. The survey will be conducted along the cable route marked in red in the maps in the Appendix to this Marine Notice.

3. Details of Vessels

The vessel to be deployed will be the “**Northern Storm**” (call sign: **MISA7**). The vessel will display all appropriate lights and signals. The vessel will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 16 and any relevant local port, VTS or working channels as required for the area.
