Diving Operations in the Kinsale and Seven Heads Gas Fields

The Department of Transport has been advised that Kinsale Energy will undertake diving operations in the Kinsale and Seven Heads Gas Fields in order to perform decommissioning activities on and around the subsea infrastructure.

1. Notice of Activity

The works are due to commence on or around 10 May 2021 and are estimated to last 25 days. However, please note the start date and the duration of the activity is weather dependant.
