Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishers, Yachtsmen and Seafarers

# Green Rebel Marine Geophysical Survey Activity West Coast of Ireland.

The Department of Transport has been advised that Green Rebel Marine intends to conduct a geophysical survey campaign using multibeam echosounder and sub-bottom profiling systems off the West Coast of Ireland.

### 1. Notice of Activity

The works are due to commence on or around 26 April and will continue until 4 June 2021 (approximate duration of 15 days). However, please note both the start date and the duration of the activity is weather dependant.

The survey will be conducted by the "**Roman Rebel**", a Semi-SWATH catamaran (call sign **2ICA5**). This vessel will conduct 24-hour operations. All equipment is hull mounted.
