Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishers,
Yachtsmen and Seafarers

Corrib Gas Field Offshore Subsea Maintenance Works

1. Notice of Activity

The Department of Transport has been advised by Vermilion Exploration & Production Ireland Limited of a maintenance campaign at the Corrib Gas Field subsea infrastructure. The work scope includes electrical fault finding of the subsea infrastructure. The maintenance works are due to commence on **24 January 2025** and will last for approximately **3 days**, subject to weather and operational constraints.

2. Location of Activity

The maintenance of the subsea infrastructure will be undertaken at the location provided in the table below. A map of the area where the maintenance operations will take place is available in the appendix to this Marine Notice.

3. Details of Vessel

The vessel "**Normand Subsea**" (call sign: **LAWI7**) will undertake the subsea operations of the maintenance campaign. All equipment used during the operations will be vessel and/or Remotely Operated Vehicle (ROV) mounted. The vessel will be listening on VHF Ch. 16 throughout the project.
