Tralee Bay Fenit Harbour Buoy Deployment

1. Notice of Activity

The Department of Transport has been notified by LCF Marine of the deployment of two data buoys in Tralee Bay as part of a dredge monitoring operation for Fenit Harbour. The buoys were deployed on **Tuesday, 11 March 2025** and will be in place for **9 weeks**.
