

2010 Sailing Instructions Supplementary Information Race 5

<u>Dun Laoghaire – Dun Laoghaire Day Race</u> Sunday 13th June 2010

Organised in conjunction with the Royal Alfred Yacht Club www.rayc.ie

This ISORA race will be run with the Lee Overlay/Royal Alfred Yacht Club 2010 Offshore Series race using the same start, course and finish. Boats may enter both series. Boats entered in the ISORA series only shall not be scored in the Lee Overlay/RAYC series nor are eligible for prizes in that series.

TIME OF START FOR ALL CLASSES

- 09.55 Warning signal Class flags (Numerals 1 & 2) hoisted
- 09.56 Preparatory Signal Blue Peter hoisted
- 09.59 Blue Peter down
- 10.00 Start Class flags down

The start may be broadcast on VHF Channel 72.

STARTING LINE

The start line shall be located in Scotsman's Bay in the vicinity of DBSC 'Pier' mark between the mast of a committee boat flying the NYC burgee and DBSC "Pier Mark". A boat shall not start later than 15 minutes after her Starting signal. Prior to the start of each race boats are requested to obtain acknowledgement from the Race Committee.

THE COURSE

It is intended that the finish will be no later than 17.00 for any boat. The course will be selected on the day to take into account the tide and wind conditions on the day.

- 1. STARTING LINE
- 2. To Be Selected
- 3. FINISH LINE

The Course will be confirmed at a briefing at 08.45 at the Marina offices and afloat to the competitors on channel 72 before the start.

TIME LIMIT

The time limit for the race shall be 18.00.

FINISH LINE

The finish line shall be between the pier ends at the Dun Laoghaire Harbour entrance.

When approximately 5 miles from the finishing line and again when approximately 10 minutes from the finish line yachts shall advise of their approach on VHF Ch 72 call sign 'ISORA Finisher'. Please note that the finisher will only have a handheld radio and you may not receive an acknowledgment to the first contact.

The finish time and the name of the boat ahead and behind shall be recorded. Also the time of rounding each mark should be recorded in the log by each boat and text to ISORA at 00353 87 2545037 as soon as possible after the race.

RETIREMENTS

Telephone National Yacht Club 00353 1 2805725 and text ISORA on 00353 87 2545037. For safety it is recommended to also inform the coastguard

NOTES

- 1. Keep a close lookout for commercial traffic when entering or exiting Dun Laoghaire. The Stena can be hard to spot from behind the breakwater.
- 2. The time of crossing the finish line should be noted in the log.
- 3. Berthing for visiting yachts will be available on the NYC pontoon. Please advise before hand to ensure space is available.
